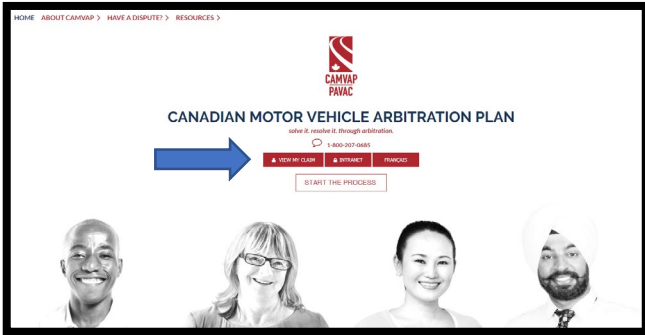
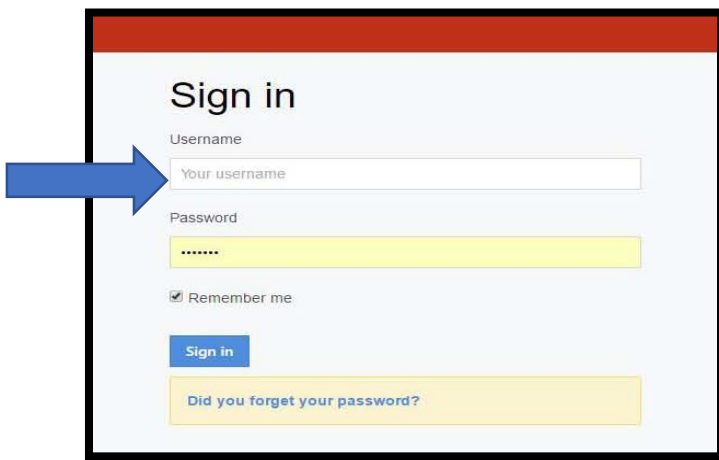


Logging in to the Claims Management System FAQ

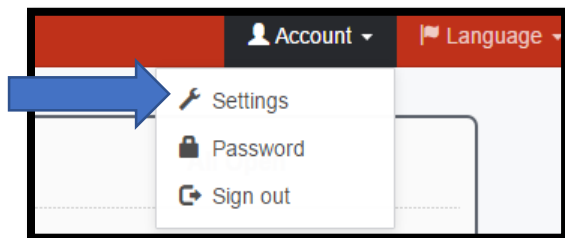
Why do I receive an error message when I try to log



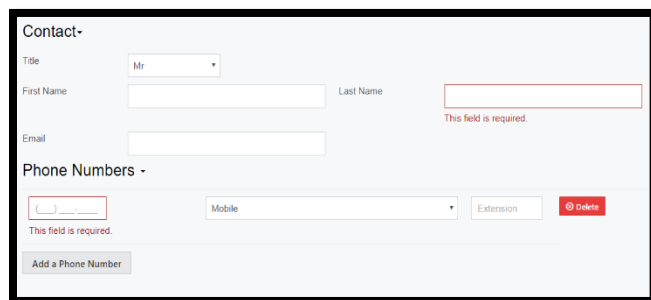
Typically, you will receive an error message when you enter your email address in the 'username' field.
