



## Notice

**Changes to the Agreement for Arbitration that will take effect for cases proceeding to a technical inspection on or after 12:01 am EST on June 9, 2023**

### **Extended Technical Inspection Notice to Manufacturers**

The minimum time for the Provincial Administrator to provide notice to the manufacturer of the date, time, and location of the technical inspection increases from two (2) full business days to five (5) full business days.

### **Extended Timeline to Complete Technical Inspections**

The maximum time for technical inspectors to complete an inspection and submit a technical inspection report increases from ten (10) business days to thirteen (13) business days.

### **Mandatory Reporting of Test Equipment Used in Technical Inspections**

Technical inspectors are now required to report and identify test equipment used in the inspection including the name, model, last calibration date (if applicable), and software version (if applicable).

### **Added Clarity Surrounding Inspection Facility Selection**

Technical inspection orders, completed by the arbitrator, now specifies that the technical examiner will select the location for the inspection of the vehicle based on the specific requirements of the inspection set out by the arbitrator.
